Dear Parents and Carers,

As per advice from the NSW Department of Education and Department of Health, we have made some changes to our school routines and special events, in a proactive measure to limit the impact of COVID-19 in our school.

To minimise the risk of spreading the virus at our school, a range of strategies have been implemented, including the promotion of personal hygiene measures (hand-washing, reducing face contact, cough etiquette), physical distancing, reducing mass gatherings (eg school assemblies), and reducing the mixing of students (eg reducing use of common areas and inter-school activities).

Can I please remind parents that **if your child is unwell, they should remain at home until symptoms resolve** and, where appropriate, seek advice from a medical practitioner. If any student presents at school with symptoms of a respiratory illness, parents will be contacted to collect their child. The health and safety of all of our students is paramount and I thank you in advance for supporting us in this regard. We will continue to follow current policies that are requiring self-isolation for those who have recently travelled overseas.

Several social distancing measures have also been adopted, including cancelling assemblies, excursions, incursions, travel, some events and non-essential gatherings. These cancellations also extend to inter-school arts, sports, initiative activities and events.

From today until the end of this term:

- ALL assemblies morning and whole school are cancelled until further notice.
- School Photos on 17 March have been postponed and will be rescheduled
- P&C AGM and General Meeting on 17 March is cancelled
- P&C Disco on 27 March will be rescheduled
- Friday PSSA has been temporarily ceased until further notice
- Regional Swimming Carnival on 19 March has been temporarily ceased until further notice
- Senior Choir rehearsal at Lynwood Park Public School on 18 March has been cancelled
- Our Easter Hat Parade on 9 April is cancelled
- Parent/Teacher Interviews on 7 April will be re-scheduled for a later time in the year

Any fees associated with these activities will be either credited to school accounts or held over until the event can be re-scheduled.

The Department of Education continues to provide schools with detailed advice and suggestions on how day to day activities can be adjusted with minimal disruption.
